Recommended Supply List 2025-26

It is recommended that Parcells students have the following items throughout the year:

- Pencils/Pens
- Loose Leaf Paper
- 2-3 extra notebooks
- Sleeve for carrying and protecting BYOD device (see below)
- BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) such as a laptop or Chromebook. A cell phone is not a part of BYOD and Parcells students participate in an off and out of sight policy for cell phones during the school day.
