Art and Crafts projects are displayed in the classroom.
Snack	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Learning the Snack Routine; washing hands, waiting, staying in our seat.• Taking Small bites and chewing slowly.• Throwing out cup and "napkin bowl" (coffee filter used for snack items)

Closing Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Following directions during the Closing Time Routine• Show and Tell, learning to look at the show and tell item, ask questions and take a "one finger touch."
