Activity	Highlights and Key Concepts
Opening Centers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Working with manipulatives• Sharing and taking turns• Cleaning up-putting toy baskets on shelves before lining up
Gross Motor	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sensory Motor Room• Playground• Weekly GYM activity: Ball Skills-Throwing and Catching
Carpet Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Learning the Carpet Time Routine, looking with our eyes at the circle time pocket chart for our name card• Continued reading <u>Brown Bear, Brown Bear</u>.• Featured Story: <u>The Three Bears</u>• AM Class: Learning about the story, counting (and eating!) bear crackers. AM Class also did AB patterns with red and green apple cut-outs• PM Class: Reading and recalling the story with a visual story map, learning key words/vocabulary: forest, porridge, honey, broken, small, medium, large, scared, frightened, talk about these words at home. Counting (and eating) bear crackers! The PM class has also started work in their drawing journals.
Group Centers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Learning the Group Centers Routine• <u>Red Table/Preacademics</u>: AM Working with cube blocks and manipulatives. Focusing on functional play skills with various objects and toys.• <u>Arts and Crafts Weekly Project</u>: “Bears and Dots” Made a picture with bingo marker and bear cut-out. Skill developing opportunities range from learning to use the materials to composing/designing a picture.
Snack	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Learning the Snack Routine; washing hands, waiting, staying in our seat.• Taking Small bites and chewing slowly.• Throwing out cup and “napkin bowl” (coffee filter used for snack items)
Quiet Table Play	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Learning the Quiet Table Play Routine; Choose one toy, play with it at table seat, and then put it away when finished.• The children enjoy playing with the individual bead boxes. Learning to clean up spills with dust pan and broom.
