Reading:

Students spent time this week getting to know our Reading Workshop routine. Students practiced increasing their stamina (time on task) as they read independently and worked in their centers. Also, we worked on logging in to our Raz-Kids accounts and learned how to read books using the QR reader on our classroom iPads.

Writing:

We've written our first small moment: a true story that zooms in on one moment in time. Students are working on their next small moment after listening to a mentor text, *Shelia The Brave*, called A Time I Was Brave.

Math:

Students were introduced to a few more Everyday Math games this week including Monster Squeeze and Penny Dice! These games focus on counting by one and recognizing a number's value (greater/less than). For example: the alligator's mouth eats the larger number!

Science/Social Studies:

We've worked in our weather journals to describe fall time activities and what fun we had sharing! These first graders seem to love this season and have talked about many fun things they do with their family!
