This course is for students struggling with reading in Kindergarten. Students will be grouped with like-ability learners. When registering, you need only select the time slot you prefer. Student-teacher ratio is kept very low to maximize individualized attention.

This class is designed to review and reinforce the most important concepts covered in fifth and sixth grade language arts class. It emphasizes basic skills to help prepare students for English in the fall. Students will receive 45 min of instruction in ELA concepts and then practice writing independently. The teacher will be available on Google Meet 30 minutes following the instruction to answer any questions that students might have during the writing process. The writing help will be provided through a "drop-in" format, where students who need help can log into the Google Meet, have their questions answered, and then go back to independent work.

#### Grade 8 or 9 in fall, 45 min Real-Time Instruction, 30 min Writing Help As Needed (1 section)

This course is intended for students just finishing 7th and 8th-grade. Students engage in a variety of literacy activities designed to prepare them to meet the challenges of the next year's writing and reading tasks. Students explore the fundamentals of effective communication in all its forms and experience texts and tasks that mirror grade-level literacy expectations. Students will receive 45 min instruction in ELA concepts and then practice writing independently. The teacher will be available on Google Meet 30 minutes following the instruction to answer any questions that students might have during the writing process. The writing help will be provided through a "drop-in" format, where students who need help can log into the Google Meet, have their questions answered, and then go back to independent work.

## Step Up to 6th and 7th Grade Math \$110

## Grade 6 and 7 in fall, 45 Min Real-Time Instruction, 30 Min Imagine Math Help As Needed (1 section)

This course intended for students just finishing 5th grade, or those who struggled with 6th grade math concepts. Students engage in a variety of activities designed to prepare them to meet the challenges of 6th and 7th grade math literacy. Students explore the fundamentals of math literacy, computation and logic through activities and tasks that mirror 6th and 7th grade math expectations. The course emphasizes adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing whole numbers, decimals and fractions without a calculator, using percents, solving word problems, and solving one step equations. This class builds on 6th grade content to provide a scaffold to 6th and 7th grade learning. Students will receive 45 min of instruction in Math concepts and then work independently on Math practice assigned by the teacher. The teacher will be available on Google Meet 30 minutes following the instruction to answer any questions that students might have about the assigned practice work. The Math Practice Help will be provided through a "drop-in" format, where students who need help can log into the Google Meet, have their questions answered, and then go back to independent work.

Students will engage in a variety of activities designed to reinforce the math concepts taught in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Students will explore the fundamentals of math literacy, computation and logic through activities and tasks that connect with the common core curriculum. Students will receive 45 min of instruction in Math concepts and then work independently on Math practice assigned by the teacher. The teacher will be available on Google Meet 30 minutes following the instruction to answer any questions that students might have about the assigned practice work. The Math Practice Help will be provided through a "drop-in" format, where students who need help can log into the Google Meet, have their questions answered, and then go back to independent work.
