Possible points	Requirement	Example
3 pts	cover page/ title – story must have a title and the front cover must show title, author (that's you!), and a large image representing the story	Un día en la vida de Pepe Escrito por la Señorita B. (notice what's capitalized)
2 pts	everything typed	
10 pts	at least 10 reflexive verbs from this chapter, logically and grammatically included No repeated verbs count, but you may want to reuse them anyway.	Pepe se cepilla los dientes por la mañana.  Pepe se cepilla los dientes por la noche.
10 pts	at least 10 additional vocabulary words from chapter 2A	la toalla, el secador, rápidamente, etc...
5 pts	logical order of daily activities	What would a normal person do?
5 pts	at least 5 images (at least half of one piece of paper) More is better!	
5 pts	at least 5 grammatically correct instances of the verb <i>ser</i>	Pepe es un chico. Señor Bigglesworth es un gato.
5 pts	at least 5 grammatically correct instances of the verb <i>estar</i>	Pepe está nervioso. Señor Bigglesworth está tranquilo.
5 pts	All complete sentences	Pepe se cepilla los dientes. Pepe brushes his teeth.
1-3 pts. flexibility	Creativity and effort	Your effort really shows.
