The Art Department Gallery (ADG), Wayne State University (WSU), Detroit, MI presents a call for entries for its annual Tri-County High School Exhibition. The exhibition dates are March 21 – April 4, 2014. The exhibition will feature approximately sixty artworks by high school students from Wayne, Oakland and Macomb counties.

#### **ABOUT THE GALLERY**

The Art Department Gallery hosts annual undergraduate exhibitions, graduate student exhibitions, faculty exhibitions and sabbatical exhibitions. Additionally, the gallery lends itself to provide exhibition space to community organizations with the approval of an exhibition committee. <[http://art.wayne.edu/communityarts\\_gallery.php](http://art.wayne.edu/communityarts_gallery.php)>

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Open to all 10<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade-level public, private, and home -schooled students from Wayne, Oakland and Macomb counties. Application to Wayne State University is NOT required.

#### **CONDITIONS**

Students can submit a maximum of two artworks.

Artwork must be original. Copies of published photos are not acceptable.

Applicants are encouraged, but not required to submit two-dimensional work with a maximum size of 48" in any direction. Sculptural and ceramic work must fit through a 3' by 8' door and weigh less than 70 pounds.

Video works are eligible. All accepted video works will be presented on flat screen monitors provided by the gallery. Selected videos must be looped on a DVD and have a pixel aspect ratio of 720 x 480 or higher.

### **Image and video requirements:**

- Images must be JPG files
- Image dimensions must be 5" x 7", vertical or horizontal
- Image resolution must be 300 dpi
- For each 2-D work, include up to two images
- For each 3-D work, include up to three images
- Video submissions must be uploaded to the internet and include a website link for viewing

Artists may not substitute another work for an accepted work, alter a work after submission, nor withdraw a work after it has been accepted. The Art Department Gallery reserves the right to refuse any entry which does not match the images submitted or meet the criteria. The gallery reserves the right to refuse work that is not appropriate for the space.

### **ACCEPTED WORKS**

Submissions will be juried by our department staff committee. Selections will be based on quality, presentation, and proper application format.

Selected works can be hand delivered or shipped. Instructions will be included in a notification e-mail letter. The artist entrant will be responsible for transporting their work to and from the gallery. Every precaution will be taken to handle artwork with the utmost care. However, the Art Department Gallery and Wayne State University will not be responsible for damage or loss from any cause.

### **NOTIFICATION**

Notification of accepted and non-accepted works will be sent via email on February 27, 2014

### **AWARDS**

Seven awards will be given for outstanding artworks in the exhibition:

First Place, Second Place, Third Place, Teacher Award, and 3 Honorable Mentions

**First Place:** WSU \$2,000 Scholarship Award and Workshop Award

**Second Place:** WSU \$2,000 Scholarship Award and Workshop Award

**Third Place:** \$150 Utrecht Certificate Award and Workshop Award

**Teacher Award:** \$150 Utrecht Certificate Award and Workshop Award

**Honorable Mention:** Workshop Award

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Art teachers of the award winners will be invited to participate in the workshops, which will take place in the art department studios on the main campus of Wayne State University. The scholarship awards

will be given to students who successfully apply and are accepted into the James Pearson Duffy Department of Art and Art History's Bachelor of Fine Arts program at Wayne State University.
