Session Four—August 5-16

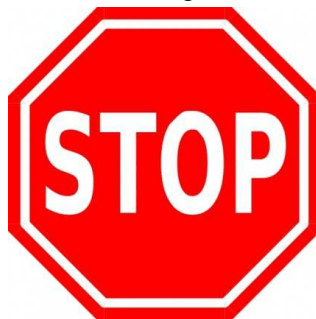

### WHAT IS SAFETY TOWN?

Safety Town is a fun-filled two week summer program where kids learn various safety lessons including: water, stranger and fire



s a f e t y . Children also will be going through the Fire Safety House.

### WHO CAN ATTEND?

The Safety Town program is geared toward children entering kindergarten or first grade in the fall.

### WHAT ARE THE DATES?

Two-week sessions begin June 17th and run through August 16th (Note: there is no Safety Town the week of July 4th).

### WHAT TIME?

The morning session begins at 9:00 AM and ends at 11:30 AM. The afternoon session begins at 12:30 PM and ends at 3:00 PM. You may choose for your child to attend either the morning or afternoon session on a first come, first serve basis.

### WHAT IS THE COST?

The cost is \$160/session, payable to GPPSS.

### WHO’S IN CHARGE?

Safety Town is under the direction of the Grosse Pointe Public School System’s childcare office. This program is presented by trained Safety Town instructors, as well as public safety officers and representatives from other community organizations.
