- 90% of graduates go immediately on to higher education. Seniors are annually accepted at over 160 different colleges and universities.

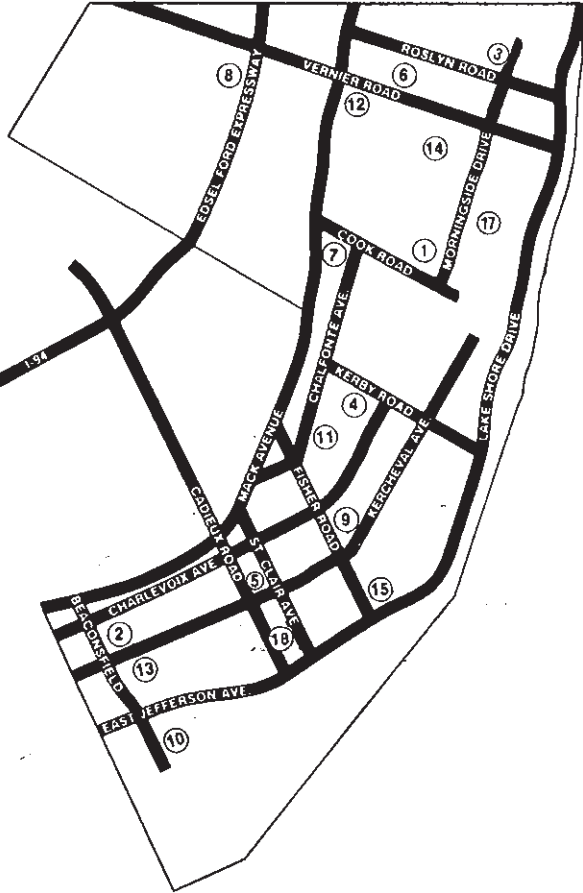

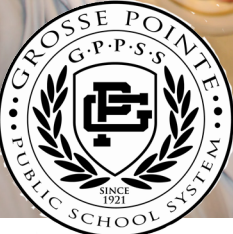
